ANNASALBE® ACE

Class 2 OTC drug

Acne medication that is an easy-to-spread and non-sticky cream for application to the skin; when applied, the cream is not noticeable on the skin.


- **ANNASALBE ACE** is a vanishing-type, easy-to-spread, and non-sticky cream for the treatment of acne. The cream is not noticeable on the skin after application.

What are the causes of acne?

In puberty, sebum (oil) secretion is increased by the action of hormones. In addition, thickening of the stratum corneum (outermost layer of the skin) occurs, blocking the drainage of sebum and forming a comedo, a hair follicle (pore) clogged with a lump of sebum (acne formed under the skin). This is the first stage of acne.


- Three actions of **ANNASALBE ACE**

1. Opening of the clogged pore and drainage of sebum




This medication softens the head of a comedo to open the pore, promoting the drainage of sebum that has accumulated in the hair follicle (acne formed under the skin).

2. Absorption and drying



This medication absorbs excess sebum to dry the affected area.

3. Anti-inflammation and disinfection



This medication relieves swelling and redness of the affected area and suppresses bacterial inflammation and purulence.



Precautions for Use



Consultation

- ① The following persons should consult a physician, pharmacist, or registered salesperson before using this medication:

- (1) Persons who are receiving any treatment from a physician
- (2) Persons who have had any allergic reactions to drugs or other substances
- (3) Persons with lesions involving an extensive area of the skin
- (4) Persons with severe skin wetness or sores
- (5) Persons with a deep wound or severe burn



- ② If any of the symptoms listed below develop after using **ANNASALBE ACE**, they might be side effects of the medication. Stop using this medication immediately and consult a physician, pharmacist, or registered salesperson, presenting this leaflet.

Affected area	Symptoms
Skin	Rash/redness, itching, and eruption

- ③ If acne symptoms do not alleviate after using **ANNASALBE ACE** for 5 or 6 days, stop using this medication and consult a physician, pharmacist, or registered salesperson, presenting this leaflet.

Indication

Acne

Dosage and Administration

Apply an appropriate amount of the cream to the affected area twice or thrice daily, using your fingertip to smooth it into the skin.


< Precautions Concerning Dosage and Administration >

- (1) Children must use this medication only under the supervision of their parents/guardians.
- (2) The cream must be applied with caution so that it does not come into contact with the eyes. Should it enter an eye, immediately wash the eye with cold or lukewarm water. If any severe reaction in the eye continues after washing, consult an ophthalmologist.
- (3) This medication is for external use only.
- (4) Prior to use, test this medication by applying a small amount to the inside of the elbow at bedtime (overnight application). If any symptoms of hypersensitivity (e.g., rash/redness, itching, and eruption) occur at the application site by the next morning, this medication must not be used.

- Wash your face before applying the cream to the acne and its surrounding area.
- Application at bedtime (night-time use) is effective.

How to make a hole on the top of the tube (illustration below)

Hold the cap with the upper side pointing downward, and press it firmly onto the top of the tube.



Ingredients

Sulfur... 3.0%, Resorcin... 2.0%
Glycyrrhetic acid... 0.3%

Excipients: Anhydrous silicic acid, cetanol, medium-chain triglyceride, bentonite, sodium cetyl sulfate, propylene glycol, glycerin stearate, lactic acid, sodium pyrosulfite, and paraben

Points of Acne Treatment

● Always keep your face clean.

Wash your face often with a cleansing foam to remove excess sebum.

Keep your hair and hands clean because acne may worsen if it comes into contact with unclean hair or hands.

Pay attention to your hair style to avoid skin irritation caused by hair ends.

● Pay attention to your food.


Avoid eating overly greasy, sweet, or spicy foods, and make sure there is enough fiber in your daily diet to ensure regular bowel movements.

● Maintain regular lifestyle habits.

Mental stress can also worsen acne. Maintain a regular lifestyle and routine, including getting enough sleep and doing moderate exercise.

Precautions for Storage and Handling

- (1) Store the product in the tube with the cap closed tightly, in a cool place away from direct sunlight.
- (2) Keep out of the reach of children.
- (3) Do not transfer the contents to another container (which may lead to drug misuse or changes in the quality of this product).
- (4) Do not use this medication after the expiration date. After the tube has been opened, make sure to use the product before the expiration date is reached.
- (5) Wipe the outer edge of the tube tip carefully after each use, and close the cap tightly to prevent deterioration of the ingredients.
