## Department of Surveying and Information Technology

### Feature 1

The curriculum is accredited by the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism, and graduates are eligible to become assistant surveyors with national certification. After graduation, students can apply for the higher qualification of professional surveyor with 2 years of work experience.

### Feature 2

Students study together with Japanese students. The pass rate for this national qualification is about 10% to 30% of the normal national examinations, so Japanese students are also admitted to Fukuoka KOKUSEN, where they can obtain the qualification without taking the exam. Students can grow through friendly collaboration with students from various countries.

### Feature 3

Fukuoka KOKUSEN boasts an overwhelming employment record, with a 100% employment rate for 20 consecutive years. For more than 10 years since we started accepting international students, both employment and visa acquisition rates have been 100%. We sincerely recommend this school to students who want to work as engineers in Japan.

## Department of International Information Business

### Feature 1

In addition to business studies such as marketing, accounting, and entrepreneurship, our unique curriculum consists of CAD and construction classes filled with Fukuoka KOKUSEN's know-how, which will lead to great opportunities for students who wish to work as highly skilled individuals in Japan. Another advantage of our program is that we have excellent instructors who have experience working in the private sector or as former executives.

### Feature 2

Career design is conducted on a regular basis. At the time of enrollment, there are many international students who say they want to work in Japan but have not yet decided what kind of work they want to do. For such students, the career design time is very valuable. Our specialists in international student employment support will meet with each student individually and carefully follow up with them to help them find a job that suits their background, prepare a resume, and prepare for interviews.

Project work is conducted as a graduation assignment. ### Part-time job introduction

### Scholarship

FKJ scholarship is available for students with excellent grades. Students can receive a scholarship of 60,000-120,000 yen per year.
