

Liquids to be inspected

Individual containers must not exceed 100 ml (g) and must be placed inside a transparent, resealable plastic pouch no larger than 1 liter in capacity.

Liquids to be treated as exceptions

Pharmaceuticals are not restricted to 100 ml (g) in volume or need to be placed in a plastic pouch under 1 liter in capacity but must be declared to security officers.
